SCF Arizona Honors Papillon for Stellar Safety Record

SCF Arizona presented Papillon Grand Canyon Helicopters the first of its new Sentinel Awards to recognize companies whose management and employees show a commitment to workplace safety.

Company President Brenda Halvorson and her management team accepted the honor Dec. 6 at the Grand Canyon from SCF Sales and Marketing Director Rick Jones.

Arizona companies qualify for a Sentinel Award if they work with their employees to develop a culture of safety in their workplace, rank among SCF Arizona's Top 100 policyholders, have a positive working relationship with SCF, maintain a loss ratio under 40 percent for the policy year and record no fatalities during the policy year.

SCF is Arizona's largest provider of workers' compensation insurance covering nearly 70 percent of businesses, large and small, statewide. SCF also only provides coverage to companies operating in Arizona.

Papillon is the only helicopter company that is certified to fly both the south and west rims of the Grand Canyon. It provides unforgettable, narrated flights that descend 4,000 feet into the canyon, considered to be one of the Seven Wonders of the World.

With landing sites at the bottom of the Grand Canyon, Papillon's customers receive a close-up view of the banks of the Colorado River and the pristine Hualapai lands, Boulder City, Lake Mead, the Hoover Dam and extinct volcanoes.

With frequent departures throughout the day, Papillon's Dragon Head tour takes off from the Grand Canyon National Park Airport, crosses Zuni Point and flies through the Zuni corridor. Tourists see the Desert View Watchtower, the Painted Desert and the Navajo Indian Reservation, along with Temple Butte, Kaibab Plateau and Kaibab National Forest.
